3 Minutes of the last meeting

5 Matters Arising

Village Questionnaire. Dr Thomas took us through his report (attached to these minutes) following an analysis of the questionnaires completed by the residents of Woolverstone. His opening comment was that the level of response was extraordinarily high.

Nursery Development. The council were advised that there still was no response with regard to the ownership of the triangle of land at the entrance to the development.

The chairman reported that the developer's contractors had burnt polluting substances on two occasions recently, ignoring a warning issued last year. The developer should be taken to task and a complaint made with the District Council for the lack of action taken.

Queen's 90th birthday. The Chairman was meeting Mr Pat York from the Royal Harwich yacht club to discuss the involvement of the village in their celebration.

Section 106 agreement relating to HMS Ganges application. Noted that the final version was still not on the website.

Extension of speed limit. Evidence from householders and other interested parties is being collected. This to be submitted to Mr D Wood who will present the evidence to the Area Officer to investigate and if he considers there to be a case, to include it on the agenda for the Speed Limit Panel.

Further business from the agenda to be postponed and the meeting was closed at this point at 2020 as the start of the Annual Parish Meeting was 20 minutes late.
